Maps	Under <b>Search Type</b> , select <b>Author Keywords</b> . Type <b>Harvard Map Collection digital maps</b> in the <b>Search For</b> box. <b>Search</b> . <i>Links added as available.</i>	In <b>Find E-Resources</b> , select <b>Keyword</b> search. In the <b>Any Word</b> box, enter <b>maps</b> . Click <b>Go</b> to view e-resources that contain maps.	<b>Search HGL</b> —the Harvard Geospatial Library—for access to electronic geospatial data sets and vector and raster maps.
Archives (including manuscripts and special collections)	<i>Records include links to finding aids where available.</i>	In <b>Find E-Resources</b> , select <b>Keyword</b> search. Under <b>Resource Type</b> , choose <b>Archival Materials</b> . <b>Go</b> .	<b>Search OASIS</b> —Online Archival Search Information System—for electronic finding aids. <i>Records include links to images, audio, and text where available.</i>
Newsmedia	<i>Records include links to digital content where available.</i>	In <b>Find E-Resources</b> , select <b>Keyword</b> search. Under <b>Resource Type</b> , choose <b>Newsmedia</b> . <b>Go</b> .	
Audio		In <b>Find E-Resources</b> , select <b>Keyword</b> search. Under <b>Resource Type</b> , choose <b>Sound Recordings</b> . <b>Go</b> .	
Statistics and Data		In <b>Find E-Resources</b> , select <b>Keyword</b> search. Under <b>Resource Type</b> , choose <b>Statistics and Data</b> . <b>Go</b> .	<b>Search HGL</b> (see above) or <b>HMDC</b> —Harvard-MIT Data Center—for quantitative social science data from international consortia.
Dictionaries and Encyclopedias	<i>Records include links to digital content where available.</i>	In <b>Find E-Resources</b> , select <b>Keyword</b> search. Under <b>Resource Type</b> , choose <b>Dictionaries and Encyclopedias</b> . <b>Go</b> .

## Catalogs

Locate materials in Harvard's libraries, museums, and archives. Harvard's catalogs, including HOLLIS, VIA, OASIS, HGL, and HMDC, contain descriptions of Harvard's holdings and include links to digital content.

Search the catalogs for a rich array of photographic collections, documents, musical scores, prints, drawings, historical maps, books, legal transcripts, diaries, manuscripts, and more. Searches in HOLLIS and VIA can be restricted to digital material.

## E-Research @ Harvard Libraries

Locate e-journals, databases and other e-resources using E-Research @ Harvard Libraries.

- Search multiple catalogs and resources at once with **Quick Search** or **Cross Search**.
- Use **My Research** to save sets of e-resources, e-journals, and citations.
- Access tools such as **Citation Linker** and **RefWorks**.

## Quick Search

An easy way to do initial searches for articles and books in broad topic areas

- Select **Harvard Lib Catalogs** to search for Harvard's holdings in several Harvard catalogs simultaneously.
- Choose a subject area to search simultaneously across selected e-resources.

## Find E-Resources

Locate and connect to more than 700 electronic resources, including indexes, encyclopedias, and e-book or e-journal collections.

- Use the **Subject** option to browse resources by topics such as film, TV, and theater; music; African studies; agriculture; chemistry; geography; and more.
- Use the **Keyword** option of **Resource Type** to browse resources by categories, such as image collections, audio recordings, biographies, newsmedia, subject gateways, and more.

## Find E-Journals

Locate and connect to individual electronic journals

- Search or browse by journal title or ISSN.
- Create personal lists of e-journals.

## Cross Search

Search multiple e-resources at once using **Quick Sets** or sets created by **Keyword** and/or **Resource Type** searches

## Screen-Reader Access
